



SEPTEMBER 2019 MEETING:

Image Based Technology for Construction – Connecting the Physical and Digital Worlds

Images convey more information, faster and with less misunderstanding than any other form of communication. There are multiple technologies available to capture digital images of the jobsite. Digital imagery opens the door to computer processing that turns static images into highly functional data while increasing efficiency by automating the overall workflow.

This presentation will describe several image capture technologies applicable to a construction site, discuss the equipment, processes, and costs associated with image capture, and outline strengths and weaknesses of the image processing technology.

At the end of the presentation participants should have a better understanding of technologies and capabilities that are available to them today. They should gain insights into how these technologies can be used and better understand some of the cost/benefit trade-offs.

- Understand the current image capture technologies.
- Understand the cost of equipment, software and manpower for each technology.
- Understand the trade-offs associated with technology selection.
- Learn how to create highly functional data from digital images.

- Review current photo documentation specifications and identify possible changes to incorporate new technology.
- Look into the future for the next technical innovations.
